1. Q. Do you need the duplexer cables for the duplexer? If so, do you need part numbers listed separately?

A. No.
2. Q. Do you need the mounting brackets & screws for cabinet? If so, do you need part numbers listed separately?

A. No.
3. Q. On the antenna, do you need lightning protection quoted? If so, do you need part number listed separately?

A. No.
4. Q. On the antenna, do you need coaxial cable quoted? If so, can you advise the length of cable needed?

A. This should be a turn key item.
5. Q. On the antenna, do you need connectors for the coaxial cable quoted?

A. This should be a turn key item.
6. Q. Will all the repeaters be installed at the same time and if so, the locations of each?

A. Location and installation dates will be determined at a later time by HCPS.
7. Q. Which of your current FCC licenses and frequencies need to be modified? Please provide frequency and call sign of each license that need modification.

A. Currently none.
8. Q. XPR8300 Model # AAM27JQR9JA7_N is for an XPR8400 repeater, and the XPR8300 is obsolete and no longer manufactured. Can I assume you will accept that model number, which is an XPR8400, which replaced the XPR8300 over a year ago?

A. Yes. XPR8400 is acceptable.
9. Q. There is no mention of what schools are to have the repeaters installed.

A. Location and installation dates will be determined at a later time by HCPS.
10. Q. What is the length of cables needed for that location?

A. Price cables by the foot.
11. Q. More information is needed in order to procure the FCC licenses.

A. Licensing would be per location and will be provided on an LOA "fixed" worksheet.
